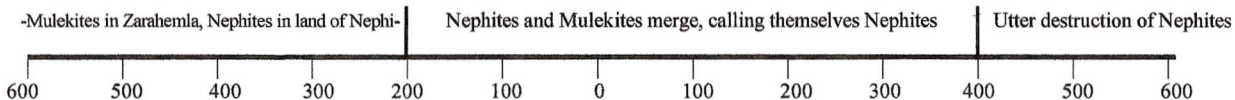
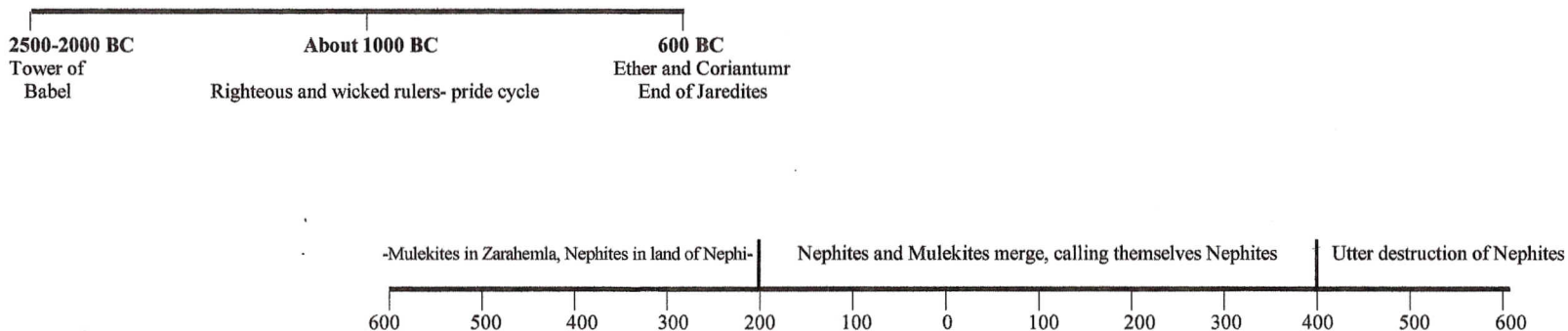


Timeline From the Book of Mormon

The Nephites 600-200 BC - The Small Plates

600 BC Lehi leaves Jerusalem
 588 BC Separation of Nephites and Lamanites. Lehi dies and Nephi is the prophet.
 544-521 BC Nephi dies, Jacob keeps plates.

500 BC
 544-421 BC Jacob dies, gives plates to Enos.

400 BC
 420 BC - Jarom commanded to keep plates
 361 BC- Omni receives plates
 317 BC- Amaron keeps plates

300 BC
 Between 279-130 BC - plates delivered to Chemish

200 BC Nephites and Mulekites merge.

The Nephites 200 BC - 0 BC (large plates)

200 BC Mosiah I
 200BC Zeniff leaves to find land of Nephi.

175 BC
 160 BC Noah receives kingdom from Zeniff.
 150 BC Abinadi preaches to wicked priests and Noah.

150 BC Benjamin
 148 BC Abinadi is martyred.
 148 BC Alma believes and flees with others.

125 BC 124 BC King Benjamin gives Mosiah charge of plates and Kingdom.
 122-21 Limhi is king, people escape to Zarahemla.
 120 BC Alma organizes church in Zarahemla.

100 BC 92 BC Conversion of Alma the younger. Sons of Mosiah go on a mission to the Lamanites. Alma receives plates.
 91 BC Alma is elected the first chief judge.

75 BC
 73 BC Captain Moroni
 53 BC Helaman

50 BC 50 BC Formation of the Gadianton Robbers.
 30 BC Nephi, son of Helaman III

25 BC Pride cycle- Fluxuation in righteousness and wickedness.

6 BC - Samuel the Lamanite prophesies to wicked Nephites

0 BC

The Nephites 1 AD - 400 AD

1 AD Christ is born.
 34 AD Major destruction. All the wicked are destroyed including the Gadianton Robbers. Christ appears and sets up his church.

100 AD Zion State exists.
 111 AD A few revolt and call themselves Lamanites.

200 AD 201 AD Growing wickedness and inequality.
 245 AD Wicked outnumber the righteous.

300 AD 306 AD Gadianton robbers in the land.
 322 AD Lord's Church is taken from land. Holy Ghost ceases to be with the people.
 336 AD Mormon begins the abridgement of plates.
 385 AD Mormon hides plates.

400 AD
 401 AD Moroni finishes the record of Mormon.
 421 AD Moroni closes his account.

Throughout this whole time, the Mulekites exist in Zarahemla, and then they merge with the Nephites.
